When Is It?

July 9th — August 2nd, Monday — Thursday
8:15 am—10:15 am **or** 10:30 am—12:30 pm

Space is VERY limited and applications will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Assessments to determine placement will begin June 11th.

What Is Provided?

Students will spend 1-2 hours of research-based math and reading instruction 4 days per week for 4 weeks. There will be a snack and break for students spending 2 hours at the clinic.

Who Will Participate?

Current Kindergarten and 1st grade students who are struggling in the areas of reading or math. (Fall 2018 1st and 2nd Graders)



How Much Will It Cost?

- Small group, reading and math instruction will average between \$3.75 and \$7.50 per 50-minutes of instruction.
- **On average, most families will pay between \$120 and \$240 for the 4 weeks of services.**
- Payments must be made during the first week of tutoring for the whole term, or in 2 payments at the beginning and at the 2-week mark.
- There will be no refunds for missed sessions.
